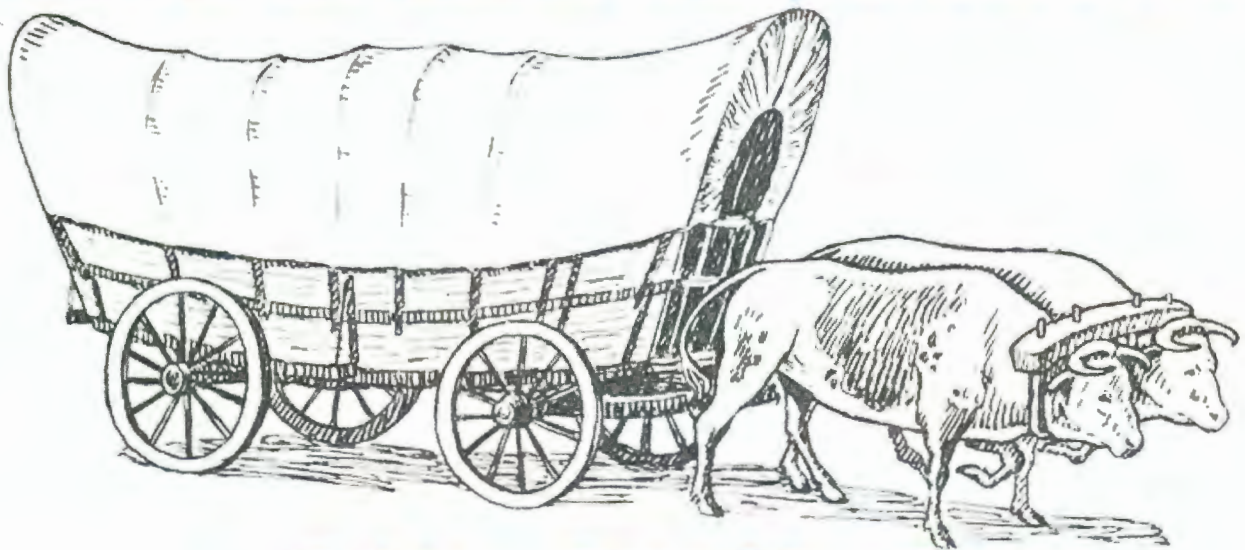


Steak BBQ Sandwich at the Museum
